





SHARE YOUR BEST BRAIN ARTWORK, COMPETE FOR A PRIZE & HELP FUNDING A PROJECT FOR BRAIN-DISEASED PERSONS

<u>Purpose</u>: to increase awareness about brain research and brain disorders and to fund a medico-social project for brain-diseased persons.

<u>Objective</u>: to collect and sell by auction images of the brain, its cells, molecules, circuits, diseases ...and beauty.

<u>Eligibility:</u> the Brain'Art Challenge is open to everybody (neuroscientists, students, lay people..). Professional artists will be invited to participate "out of competition".

<u>Submission guidelines</u>: send your artwork to <u>info@piettecommunication.com</u> directly or via wetransfer/dropbox. File format: jpg-minimum 600dpi. Provide an imaginative title and a brief, factual, easy-to-understand comment on the item shown. **Deadline**: August 20, 2018.

<u>Exhibition</u>: all images will be posted on <u>www.braincouncil.be</u>; the best artworks will be printed (50x60cm) and displayed during the "Generation 80" exhibition (<u>www.europaexpo.be</u>) at Liège-Guillemins station in October-November 2018.

<u>Prizes:</u> 3 Prizes sponsored by *Cefaly Technology*: 1st (3000€) and 2nd (2000€) selected by the jury chaired by Pierre Kroll; 3rd (1000€) chosen by the public. Award Ceremony October 18, 2018 18h30 at the Guillemins station Expo after a lecture by JP Changeux on "The Beauty in the Brain".

<u>Auctioning</u>: artworks, including those submitted out-of-competition by professional artists, will be sold by auction: half of the auction benefit for the submitter, half to sponsor a medico-social project for brain-diseased persons.
