EBC launches statement "Counting down to zero"

The proposal of the European Commission for the "Horizon Europe" programme, which was published in June 2018, included an indicative budget of €94.1 billion. Within this budget, €7.7 billion is proposed to fund the "Health" cluster which will support health research. EBC believes that these amounts are insufficient to tackle today's health challenges and launched the statement "Counting down to zero: Towards a future with underfunded health research?" which calls on the EU institutions to adopt a more robust 9th Framework Programme.

Results of EFNA's Survey of Young Europeans with Neurological Conditions

In celebration of World Brain Day 2018, the European Federation of Neurological Associations (EFNA) has released results of its recent Survey of Young Europeans with Neurological Conditions. Between March 12th and May 15th 2018, 1368 responses to the survey were received from 39 countries. Almost 80% of the respondents were female, with the majority of the responses coming from Multiple Sclerosis, Myalgic Encephalomyelitis, Chronic Pain and Migraine.
