The European Brain Council showcased its current projects during the **ECNP Congress**, held in Lisbon and online on 2-5 October.

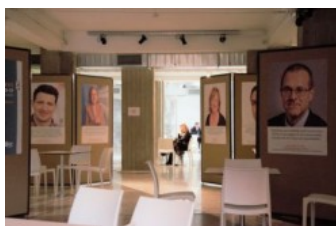
In the context of the event, EBRA was highlighted with a poster on-site available for all the attendees.

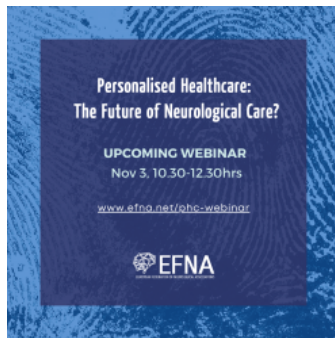

Survey: Are mental health needs being met by services?, Quality of Life project & Suicide Awareness in Young Men

After the successful outcome of its first COVID Survey, GAMIAN-Europe has launched a second [survey on the impact of COVID-19](#). This survey, developed in collaboration with the European Psychiatric Association, aims to explore the impact of the pandemic on mental health care and services, from the patient and clinician's perspective. It is currently available in 5 European languages (more to come shortly).

For World Mental Health Day, GAMIAN-Europe has released a booklet entitled '[Top tips for finding and achieving quality of life beyond a mental health condition](#)'. This guide was co-created with patients and includes different tips for improving quality of life. We also launched a series of blogs and a [video](#), with testimonials of individuals about their journeys and personal tips for other patients. More information can be found on our website!

Suicide is commonly described as a 'male phenomenon', as men are 4 to 5 times more likely to die by suicide compared to women, in the European Union. For this reason, GAMIAN-Europe has decided to develop a project on this topic, together with the Euro Youth for Mental Health. This project aims to explore and raise awareness of the mental health challenges faced by young males during the pandemic and the causes behind a potential increase in suicide ideation amongst this population group. ...Stay tuned for more updates!
