The BRAINTEASER Project has reached the halfway stage

BRAINTEASER Project, which the European Brain Council is part of, has reached the halfway stage. Started in January 2021, this 4-year data science project employs AI-based clinical software and mobile apps to support patients with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and multiple sclerosis, their clinicians and families.


