EBC joins EU-level mental health organisations call on EPSCO Council for concrete action on mental health

On July 28, on the occasion of the informal EPSCO Council, EBC joined 5 organisations active in the area of mental health representing mental health professionals, patients, carers and brain researchers, to call on the Spanish Presidency to consider proposing concrete EU-level action on mental health.

This call is issued against the background of the recent Commission Communication entitled 'A comprehensive approach to mental health', adopted on 7 June; this provides the right context for in-depth reflection on what would be required to improve mental health and prevent mental illhealth on the ground. Action is clearly needed, as currently, in the EU, one in four people is affected by mental health issues.

BRAINTEASER: Assessing Predictive Algorithms and Enabling Data Sharing for Enhanced Research

Each year, the BRAINTEASER project organizes an open evaluation challenge, called iDPP@CLEF (Intelligent Disease Progression Prediction), to involve research groups from academia and industry in the assessment of the performance of their Al algorithms to predict the progression of ALS and MS. These challenges are open to anyone wishing to participate and they are built around real clinical and sensor data (properly anonymized), provided by the clinical partners in our consortium.

The challenges represent a unique opportunity for researchers to access highly curated data and discuss their own approaches with other researchers interested in the same topics. Indeed, since all the groups participating in a challenge operate on the same datasets, it is possible to directly contrast the performance of all the proposed approaches and solutions, in order to comparatively understand what works best and what does not work.



Strategic framework for improvement of mental health in the Republic of Croatia until 2030

The Croatian Government adopted the Strategic Framework for Mental Health until 2030. The document recognizes mental health as a public health priority and stresses the need to undertake comprehensive and specific measures of health promotion, prevention and protection of mental health and treatment of mental disorders.

The purpose of the Strategic Framework is to define, in line with other strategic documents, the long-term goals for the improvement of mental health protection in order to decrease the occurrence of mental health disorders and related disability and to increase the accessibility of mental health services. Main areas for developing quality mental health care include raising awareness about mental health problems, timely detection and diagnosis and appropriate treatment and rehabilitation.
