Value of Treatment Collection Published in European Psychiatry Special Issue

On the occasion of **World Mental Health Day** on 10 October 2023, <u>The European Psychiatry</u> released a **Special Issue** on <u>The Value of Treatment (VOT)</u> focusing on Early Intervention and Continuity of Care for Mental Disorders (Anorexia Nervosa, Autism and Major Depressive Disorder).

With this new Study, the **European Brain Council (EBC)**, together with its <u>members</u> and academic partners (Hospital Universitario Gregorio Maranon, King's College London, The London School of Economics and Political Science and University of Greenwich, is not only looking at the socioeconomic impact and value of optimal healthcare interventions but is also emphasizing how timely care pathways are likely to need greater integration and how collaborative care between primary care and specialist care — inexistant in many countries — can be achieved in the future for the benefit of those living with a mental disorder.

The <u>conference on Rare diseases and European reference networks</u> was organised under the auspices of the Spanish Presidency of the EU Council and in cooperation with the authorities of the Basque Country. It took place on 11th October 2023 in the Euskalduna Conference Centre in Bilbao, Spain.

Vinciane Quoidbach, Public Health and Policy Research Project Manager at EBC, took part in a session on "Action at European level" where she highlighted the need to pursue the intense research being conducted in many areas related to ALS, from basic science seeking the roots of the disease to therapy development to find effective treatments, and shared the outcomes of the EU Action Plan on Rare Diseases, published in the framework of the <u>Value of Treatment project</u>, coordinated by EBC.

Celebrating 100 years of neurosurgery in **Serbia**

The Serbian Neurosurgical Society organised the 9th SNSS Annual Meeting and the 10th SNSS Congress with international participation from 30 October to 3 November in Belgrade, marking two significant milestones in the field of neurosurgery in Serbia; the 85th anniversary of the Neurosurgery Clinic of the University Clinical Center of Serbia and the 100th anniversary of Neurosurgery in Serbia. On October 31, 1938, Prof. Milivoje Kostic, one of the pioneers in the field of surgery in this region, established in Belgrade the first neurosurgery department in Serbia and Yugoslavia, only three years after the first neurosurgical department in Germany, in Wurzburg. The Neurosurgery Clinic today is the leading neurosurgical institution in Serbia and the bearer of most activities of the Serbian neurosurgeons. Neurosurgeons from across Europe gathered in the Serbian capital for a busy neurosurgical week, featuring a rich and dynamic scientific and social program. 31st of October was a dedicated day for EANS activities. Warm congratulations to our colleagues from Serbia for a gathering of 1000 participants to celebrate Neurosurgical achievements!


