### **Brain Health & Research Day Highlights**

On the occasion of the 78th United Nations General Assembly, the European Brain Council in collaboration with the Baker Institute for Public Policy, the Brain Capital Alliance, the Brain Health Nexus and supporting partners hosted a Brain Health & Research Day on 18 September 2023 at the Harvard Club of New York City as part of the Science Summit, bringing together over 150 key stakeholder organisations all committed to the same goal: fostering and enhancing global collaboration in the brain area, with the ultimate goal of improving the lives of people living with brain conditions, neurological and mental alike.

The above-mentioned <u>Call to Action</u>, launched at the end of the event, reflects the urgent calls from the brain community – highlighting the priorities to address the burden of brain disease and improve brain health in the future and outlines a set of calls to the United Nations and Member States.

## Brain Health & Research Day Highlighted in the Lancet Neurology

The 78th Session of the UN General Assembly (<u>UNGA 78</u>) was gathering in New York City as this issue of *The Lancet Neurology* was sent to press. The aim of UNGA 78 is to "rebuild trust and reignite global solidarity" by "accelerating action on the 2030 Agenda and its Sustainable Development Goals [SDGs]". UN Secretary-General António Guterres' has appealed for "a renewed impetus and accelerated actions", which will be the focus of the <u>2023 SDG Summit</u> that takes place alongside UNGA 78. During the countdown to 2030, for countries to achieve the SDG to "ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages", more emphasis on brain health will be crucial.

The Lancet highlights the Science Summit taking place, particularly EBC's event, alongside the General Assembly, stating that "without solidarity with, and consideration for, the billions of people affected by brain diseases worldwide, it will be difficult to "rebuild trust" and accelerate action to achieve the SDGs".

## Two brain events held at UNGA78 - Brain Capital Building: Brain Deals to Harness Al and Drive SDG Implementation

On 19 September 2023, a second brain-focused event was held, Brain Capital Building @ UNGA: Brain Deals to Harness AI and Drive SDG Implementation by 2030, which EBC was happy to be part of. As The Lancet Neurology put it when they highlighted EBC's event in an article marking the kick-off of the 78th United Nations General Assembly: "during the countdown to 2030, for countries to achieve the SDG to "ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages", more emphasis on brain health will be crucial," and holding two brain-related events at the start of UNGA78 couldn't have been more timely to argue this very important point. "Without solidarity with, and consideration for, the billions of people affected by brain diseases worldwide, it will be difficult to "rebuild trust" and accelerate action to achieve the SDGs."
